In addition, construction will commence later this year on two new concrete netball courts at the Woorinen Recreation Reserve.

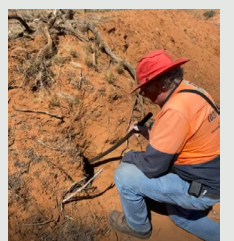


ROBINVALE LEARNING AND COMMUNITY HUB PAVING
