10 YEARS OF L2P

Local Young drivers and dedicated volunteer mentors recently gathered to celebrate the 10th Anniversary of Swan Hill's TAC L2P program.

Celebrations had been rescheduled from 2020 and made it just in time to avoid the 7-day lockdown.

Over the past decade the TAC L2P Program has:

- helped 352 Learner drivers
- assisted 115 people to gain licenses
- involved 82 mentors, and
- undergone 5000 hours of driving experience.
