SWAN HILL REGIONAL ART GALLERY



Textured Kindness Cards - Tuesday 11 April

Children will explore positive messages and wellbeing through art by creating hand decorated textured kindness cards. They will add colour to the card using watercolour paints and add texture with Magiclays and further detail with paint markers.



DIY Marker and Ink Aprons - Thursday 13 April

Explore the art elements of shape and pattern to create their own apron design using a combination of food dyes and fabric markers.



Field of Poppies/ANZAC Day art activity - Tuesday 18 April

Children will explore the symbolism of Poppies and their relationship to war by creating a Field of Poppies. They will develop techniques in printing by using a sponge to create marks that resemble poppies and will then work over their printed shapes with pens and markers to add details & emphasise the shapes of the flowers.



Artist inspired wooden Wavy Photo Frame - Thursday 20 April

Children will explore different artists and their styles as inspiration. Students will decorate a frame using paint markers and Magiclays drawing inspiration from their chosen artist's style. Children will decide what image they will put into their frame and how their inspirational artist relates to the image.
