Conditions for doorknocking permit

- 1. Before a permit is granted, you must provide a Certificate of Currency issued to you by your insurance provider. The Certificate must include public liability coverage of at least \$20 million.
- 2. Doorknocking is restricted to residential areas only and not permitted in commercial, industrial or shopping areas.
- 3. Doorknocking is only permitted during 9.00am and 6.00pm.
- 4. All volunteers must wear uniforms and/or identification badges.
- 5. The collection of money is for the sole purpose of fundraising for the charity or organisation named above.

Conditions for intersection collections

- 1. Before a permit is granted, you must provide a Certificate of Currency issued to you by your insurance provider. The Certificate must include public liability coverage of at least \$20 million.
- 2. Access to public roads and walkways must not be obstructed.
