


Planning application checklist – Liquor License

Mandatory information to be submitted with planning application.	
1	Full copy of land Title that is less than 3 months old , as well as copies of any restriction, covenant or agreement on Title.
2	A written statement addressing the following matters:

A report should also be provided as part of an application to address matters such as: The impact of the sale or consumption of liquor permitted by the liquor license on the amenity of the surrounding area. The impact of the hours of operation on the amenity of the surrounding area The impact of the number of patrons on the amenity of the surrounding area
3	 Site context plan clearly showing: Detailed floor layout and location of all external doors and windows on the subject premises The proposed licensed area outline in bold red (see example Page 2) Existing/proposed buildings on the site and all buildings directly adjoining the site Adjoining uses described on the plan e.g. shop, bank, office Any habitable windows/doors at adjoining buildings
