## Prime Cattle Sale 18<sup>th</sup> of June 2020

Young finished cattle prices gained some momentum at this week's SHRLE Prime Cattle Sale. This was primarily driven by a smaller yarding of just over 600 head and strong re-stocker competition. A pen of 3 excellent Charolais Cross Vealer Steers weighing an average of 338kg, topping at an impressive 467c/kg. With the reappearance of one domestic buyer, quotations for finished, slaughter ready cattle sold up to 10c/kg to 20c/kg on last fortnight. The supply of good heavy females kept processors interest peeking. Some well bred beef females topped the market at 320c/kg with the average staying between 260c/kg to 290c/kg for dairy types.
