## Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange Prime Sheep & Lamb Sale 28<sup>th</sup> May 2020

This week's Sheep & Lamb Sale saw spirited bidding amongst our core buying group with over 9100 head yarded. Supplementary fed Cross bred & Merino Lambs made up the majority, in a market that created dearer trends across the board. Export Lambs quotations averaged 700c/kg to 750c/kg topping at \$283/head for an impressive run of 119. Heavy lambs sold to 780c/kg to 820c/kg. Heavy Trade and Trade weight lambs saw the most gains topping at \$240/head with quotations making between 850c/kg and 900c/kg. A small number of Mutton was offered that saw buyers keen to raise a hand. Quotes easily averaged over \$200/head.
