Prime Cattle Sale 12th of August 2020

Agents yarded 350 head for this week's Prime Cattle Market in Swan Hill. Heavy Cows sold well averaging 337c/kg, to a top of 390c/kg. Supplementary fed cattle averaged 492c/kg for Steers & 462c/kg for the Heifer portion, topping at 566c/kg. Light calves proved the highlight of the market making out to 635.6c/kg or \$1387/head for a pen of 3 Angus heifers weighing an average of 218kgs.
