Agents yarded just over 800 head for the final Cattle Market of the 2021 selling season. Some good quality feeder types cattle were offered making anywhere from 580c/kg to 595c/kg. Beefs Cows averaged 340c/kg with buyers looking for quality. Competition for heavy cattle was minimal but the Trade run we saw stock demand from feedlotters & restockers. Market prices were up to 20c/kg cheaper in places than last fortnight.
