Did you know...

On average, the height of a cow is 1.5m (more or less) at the shoulder, and can have a lifespan of 18 to 22 years. "Big Bertha" is the world's oldest cow that lived for 48 years (March 17, 1945 – 31 December 31, 1993). Because of Big Bertha's World Record-breaking status, she became like a local celebrity and her appearances at cattle fairs helped raise over \$70,000 which was donated for cancer research and other charities.

The Chianina is an Italian breed of cattle. This breed is the heaviest, tallest, and one of the oldest cattle breeds in the world. Developed to pull ploughs and as a source of food during the Etruscan and Roman periods, the Chianina is one of the oldest purebred cattle breeds in the world. Mature male and female Chianina can reach more than 1.68m tall and weigh from 1,200 kg to over 1,500 kg.

Chianina cattle have been bred in Australia for nearly 40 years and have made a significant contribution to the country's cross bred cattle
