The yarding this week consisted on mostly younger cattle or plainer cows. Cows sold cheaper by 30-40c/kg.

Heavy kill cattle were limited in supply and were 20-30c/kg softer.

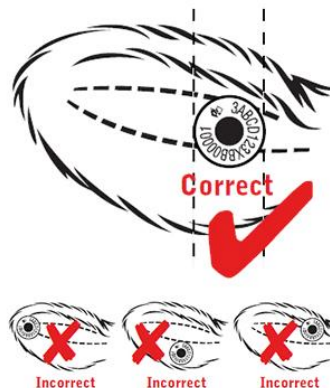
Good trade cattle were 20c/kg cheaper than a fortnight ago and the trend continued with the secondary types down by 40-75c/kg.

Did you know?

Both breeder and post-breeder tags must be attached to the centre of the right (offside) ear, as seen below: and NOT on top of the ear!



This ensures tags are read correctly when the animal walks past scanners, even when it has the ear back against it's neck.
