Did You Know?

"Pain, as Meat and Livestock Australia has identified, is one of the key issues that needs to be addressed and appropriately managed in livestock production," Professor Hutchinson, University of Adelaide.

- Research shows evidence of pain can be seen in the cells of livestock, just as it can be detected in humans
- The research could make it easier to treat chronic pain in livestock
- Animals experiencing less pain will eat better and survive longer in changing climates

This sheep is not praying. If you see your sheep doing this; they are in *pain* and need their hooves trimmed. DO NOT consign them to a saleyard where they are standing on concrete for up to 7 hours. They become lame and are not fit for sale.
