NLIS reminders and updates from Agriculture Victoria.

- Transit stock**

All transit stock unloaded at a saleyard must be scanned and sighted on the NLIS database within 48 hours of their arrival. The only details required for a 'sighted' transfer is the saleyard PIC, NLIS tag numbers and the date when the transit stock arrived at the saleyard.

- NVDs**

Vendors are required to ensure that their NVDs (or eNVDs) are delivered no later than when their livestock arrive. If NVDs arrive late, Agriculture Victoria will follow up with the vendor. If livestock arrive and no NVD has been supplied, the livestock cannot be sold.
