Submissions Process – renewed Australian Animal Welfare Strategy Purpose: To inform stakeholders that the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry is now inviting submissions on the renewed Australian Animal Welfare Strategy (AAWS) between 2 April and 31 May 2024, in addition to the survey currently underway.

- As advised in EAN 2024-05, the Australian Government has committed \$5 million over 4 years to the development of the renewed strategy, with the objective of providing a framework for a national approach to animal welfare in Australia.
